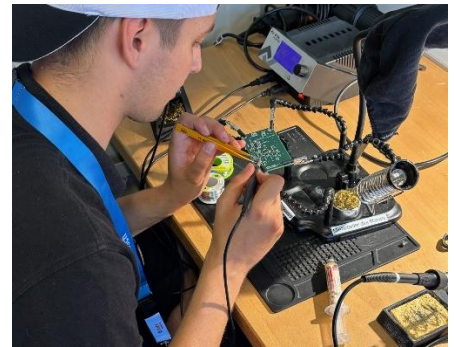
Press-fit Academy Workshop
