Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

REACH registration and information requirements in the supply chain

On 1 June 2007, the EU Chemicals Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force. According to Article 33 (1), the supplier of articles containing a substance on the ECHA Candidate List (SVHC) in a concentration above 0.1% by mass has to provide the recipient of the article with information on the safe use of the article, at least the name of the SVHC concerned

Würth Elektronik ICS GmbH & Co. KG, as a manufacturer of electronic products and a so-called "downstream user," is aware of its obligations under the REACH Regulation.

Changes to the Candidate List are continuously monitored, and efforts are made to avoid the use of substances of very high concern (SVHC) in the products.

Provisions are excluded from this confirmation.
