Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS)**

RoHS

On June 8, 2011, the EU Directive 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS) came into force.

Würth Elektronik ICS GmbH & Co. KG hereby confirms the conformity of its products with regard to the EU Directive 2011/65/EU, any extensions and delegated directives according to the current state of knowledge.

These products meet the current requirements for all designated materials max. 0,1 % by weight in homogeneous material for:

Lead
Mercury
Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)
Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)
Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) < 0,1 % by weight
diphthalate (DEHP)
butylbenzyl phthalate (BBP)
dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)
cadmium < 0,01 % by weight

Exception according to Annex III of the Directive (products with brass content or power elements):

6c: Copper alloy with a mass content of up to 4 % lead

Provisions are excluded from this confirmation.
